

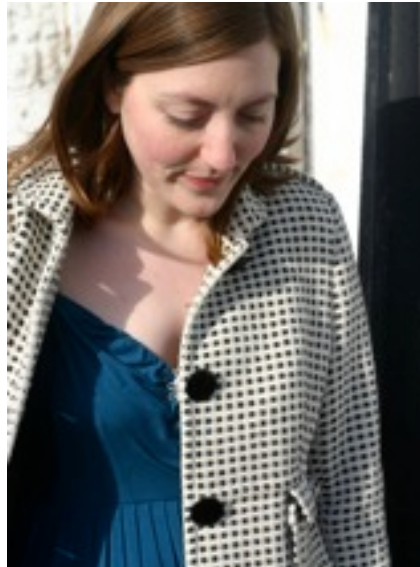

**Kelly Sulick** currently teaches at the **University of Virginia** and serves as Principal Flute in the Charlottesville and University Symphony Orchestra. Prior to her appointment, she served as Principal Flute with the Evansville Philharmonic Orchestra and as Consortium Instructor of Flute at the University of Evansville for three years. She earned her Master of Music degree in Flute Performance from the University of Southern California. Prior to her graduate studies, she earned a Bachelor of Music degree in Flute Performance and a Bachelor of Arts degree in English Language and Literature from the University of Michigan.

Ms. Sulick won second place in the 2010 National Flute Association's Young Artist Competition, and was awarded the prize for the best performance of Kristin P. Kuster's "Perpetual Afternoon." She has been a finalist or semi-finalist in numerous national competitions, and has recorded several compact discs, including William Bolcom's Songs of Innocence and of Experience under Leonard Slatkin, a Naxos release that received four Grammy awards including Best Classical Album. Her principal teachers include Jim Walker and Amy Porter.

**Elementary:** K-6th grade

**Middle School:** 7th -9th grade

**High School:** 10th-12th grade

**College:** Undergraduate or Graduate Level

**Adult Amateur:** Does not make living playing the flute

Prizes will be awarded in each category. Awards may include monetary prizes, accessories, or concert tickets. The 3 High School and College winners will perform for Kelly Sulick's Master Class at 11AM and 4 PM

**Entries for all divisions must be POSTMARKED by February 20, 2012.** You will be notified of your audition time at our web site at [www.flutefaire.com](http://www.flutefaire.com).

**Elementary, Middle School, and High School Divisions will COMPETE on Monday, March 5, 2012 at Christopher Newport University, 1 University Place, Ferguson Center for the Arts, Newport News, VA 23606 starting at 5:30 PM. Please note any audition time requests on your registration form.**

**The College Division and Adult Amateur Competitions** will be held during Flute Faire, Saturday morning, March 10, 2012. Auditions will be held 8:30 AM - 12 Noon.

There are no music eligibility requirements. Maximum solo length is 10 minutes. An accompanist must be used if the piece was written for such. If you do not have your own accompanist, one will be provided at the cost of \$5 for Elementary, \$10 for Middle School, \$15 for High School and \$20 for College and Adult. If you are using a Flute Faire accompanist, a copy of the piano score must be included with the registration form. All participants must provide one copy of the flute part to the judges on the day of the competition.

Winners will not be charged an additional fee for performing in the Master Classes.
