SSG Troy Paolantonio, a high energy and charismatic performer, is a member of the US Army Field Band Flute section. As the Army's Ambassador to our Nation and the World, The US Army Field Band regularly tours the United States telling the Army Story and honoring our soldiers and veterans. In addition to his position in the military, Troy is a sought-after performer and clinician in the US and abroad. A native of Coral Springs, FL, Troy began playing the flute at age 10 and has had a wide ranging career, performing professionally with the Tallahassee Symphony Orchestra, Miami City Ballet Orchestra, Florida Grand Opera, the Busch Gardens Tampa Bay, Opera Tampa, and Contemporary Javanese Percussion Ensemble Gamelan.. SSG Paolantonio's military career began in 2010 serving as a flutist in Uijeongbu, South Korea. In 2011, he was accepted as a fifer in the US Army Old Guard Fife and Drum Corps in Washington D.C. where he also served as an assistant drum major. He joined the US Army Field Band in August 2018. Troy gave his debut international solo recital in 2011 at the United Culture Center in Seoul, South Korea. He has performed at Carnegie Hall and been guest artist for the 2017 Kentucky Flute Festival, special guest and clinician for the 2019 Nauvoo Flute Festival, and guest clinician at numerous universities across the US. He has been finalist and prizewinner of the Florida Flute Association College Young Artist Competition, the Atlanta Flute Club Young Artist Competition, Flute Society of Washington Young Artist Competition, the Hugo Kauder International Music Competition, and the 2018 Florida State Low Flutes Symposium Alto Flute Competition. Troy Paolantonio holds degrees from The University, the University of South Florida, and completed his DMA in Flute Performance at the Catholic University of America in 2018. His mentors include Shelley Font, Rene Miska, Charles Delaney, Stephanie Jutt, Eva Amsler, Dr. Kim McCormick, Alice Weinreb, and Robert Dick. Troy has an active teaching studio in the National Capital region and is the current program chair for the Flute Society of Washington.

Prizes will be awarded in each category. Winners of Elementary & Middle School will perform in a showcase at Flute Faire. High School winners will perform in their own masterclass. College winners will perform in a masterclass for the guest artist.

Adult Amateurs have the option to perform for judges' feedback in a non-competitive environment as part of our Adult Division.

Entries for all divisions must be POSTMARKED by April 15th, 2019. Audition times will be posted on our website at www.flutefaire.com.

A Scholarship fund has been set up by Erich Graf. Please find the application at flutefaire.com. Application Due April 15th, 2019.

Elementary, Middle School, and High School Divisions will COMPETE on Monday, April 22, 2019 at Old Dominion University starting at 5:30 PM. Please note any audition time requests on your registration form.

The College and Adult Amateur Divisions will be held during Flute Faire, Saturday morning, May 4th, 2018. Rehearsals/Auditions begin at 8:30 am.

There are no music eligibility requirements. Maximum solo length is 10 minutes. An accompanist must be used if the piece was written for such. If you do not have your own accompanist, one will be provided at the cost of \$10 for Elementary, \$15 for Middle School, \$20 for High School and \$25 for College and Adult. If you are using a Flute Faire accompanist, a copy of the piano score must be included with the registration form. All participants must provide one copy of the flute part to the judges on the day of the competition. Specific audition time requests must be included with your registration
